Bayside Autism Carers Lawn Bowls Respite

### **Q2 Brief Project Description (250 words max)**

According to ABS 2016, there 780 individuals on the Autism Spectrum in the Bayside Council Area. That means close to that many carers whose lives are dedicated to the 24 hour support of their family member. While the community provides a range of support options for children, there is little focus to do something for their carers. Autism is a very isolating condition and our aim is to help bring these carers together to enjoy each other's company to relax over a light physical activity.

### **Q3 Please provide an outline of your project (500 words max)**

Parents attend regular activities designed to support their autistic children. This program is to provide an escape for them for a few hours a month where they can relax and get a little exercise in the company of others who understand them. The group will run once a month during the day while their children are at school, likely from 10.000 am to noon. With the event ending around lunchtime, they then have the option to have a meal together and further share fellowship as well as information and ideas for mutual support. Similar carers groups elsewhere have proven popular, however our aim is to provide here a place for autism carers to connect for friendship and some "time off" from their roles. To add to the support of carers, we would like to include a lunch twice during the year, one in April as part of Autism month and another in October during Carers week.
